



## NOTICE OF REPLACEMENT OF "Agricultural/Commercial/Industrial" AND "Environmental/Health/Other Interests of the General Public" REPRESENTATIVES on the

Lakehead Source Protection Committee Under O. Reg. 288/07, Clean Water Act, 2006

**Replacement** of the "Agricultural/Commercial/Industrial" and "Environmental/Health/Other Interests of the General Public" Representatives: The Lakehead Source Protection Authority is seeking two representatives from each category (total of four) to sit on the Lakehead Source Protection Committee for a term of five years.

**Summary of Functions of the Source Protection Committee:** As outlined in the *Clean Water Act, 2006*, the Lakehead Source Protection Committee has been created according to the provincial regulation and appointed by the Lakehead Source Protection Authority. The Lakehead Source Protection Committee has developed a Source Protection Plan to protect municipal drinking water sources located in the City of Thunder Bay and Municipality of Oliver Paipoonge. The Committee's ongoing responsibility is to review the effectiveness of implementation of the policies in the Approved Source Protection Plan. To accomplish this, the Committee will review and comment on the Source Protection Authority's Annual Report to the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change. The Committee may also be required to update the Assessment Report and Source Protection Plan as required by the *Clean Water Act, 2006*, and its associated regulations. It is anticipated that there will be two Source Protection Committee meetings per year.
