C'mon Over! It's Easy!

To enter Canada **BY LAND**
you need two forms of ID:



- one to prove citizenship (Birth Certificate)
- one to prove identity (Driver's Licence)

Children under the age of 18 must have ID and a phone number so Customs can confirm travel arrangements regardless of whether travelling with their parents.

U.S. CITIZENS

DO NOT NEED A PASSPORT

to enter Canada. BUT You will need a U.S. Passport to return home
as of June 1, 2009

When you enter at Pigeon River, Minnesota/Ontario
you are only 40-miles from Thunder Bay - the largest city in the region and
