A 2008 Explorer Card provides a year of unlimited access to local Conservation Areas. The \$25.00 card allows visitors to forgo paying the regular \$2.00 per vehicle fee for Conservation Areas. Plus, everyone who purchases a 2008 Explorer Card will receive a free ID tag for their pack sack, book bag or luggage as well as a Discovery Guide which features trail maps for all the Conservation Areas. Also, anyone who buys their Explorer Card before December 20, 2007 will receive a free 2008 Pocket Calendar! The 2008 Explorer Card is available only at the LRCA office, 130 Conservation Road.
