FLOOD ADVISORY***

A disturbance will bring rain and possible thunderstorms over the next 48 hours. Rainfall amounts over this period could reach up to 70 to 100 millimetres.

The threat of localized flooding exists in low lying areas from heavy downpours due to thunderstorms. The public are advised to exercise caution in and around area waterways and to remove stored items adjacent to stream banks to higher ground.

Authority staff will continue to monitor the situation.

Flood Advisory's are issued when assessed conditions indicate the potential for serious flooding exists. This Advisory is in effect until 6:00 p.m. on Saturday June 28, 2008 unless conditions change.
