FLOOD SAFETY BULLETIN***

A disturbance will bring rain and possible thunderstorms over the next 24 hours. Rainfall amounts over this period could total between 50 to 60 millimetres, with up to 100 millimetres in localized areas.

The threat of localized flooding exists in low lying areas from heavy downpours due to thunderstorms. The public are advised to exercise caution in and around area waterways.

This safety advisory is in effect until 11:00 a.m. on Saturday September 27, 2008. Authority staff will continue to monitor the situation.
