**Lakehead Conservation to host
“Living by the Lake Superior Shoreline” Open Houses**

The Lakehead Region Conservation Authority is hosting two open houses for rural residents who live along the Lake Superior Shoreline. The first open house will take place in the Municipality of Neebing at the Blake Community Hall on Tuesday, June 9, 2009. The second open house will be in the Municipality of Shuniah at the MacGregor Recreation Centre on Thursday, June 11, 2009. Both open houses will be from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. with presentations beginning at 7:15 p.m.

Participants will learn stewardship practices to help protect Lake Superior. In addition, information will be provided regarding the Authority’s Development, Interference with Wetlands and Alterations to Shorelines and Watercourses Regulations.

The Conservation Authority’s new “Stewardship Guide for the Lake Superior Shoreline” will be available to take home. It is a self assessment tool to evaluate environmental performance as a rural property owner.

Authority Chairman Bill Bartley says “living by the Lake Superior shoreline is very rewarding. Being a good steward and helping to care for the shoreline where you live will ensure it remains a treasured part of your life and our community”.
