***LAKEHEAD REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY  
FLOOD SAFETY/WATERSHED CONDITION BULLETIN***

A disturbance will bring rain over the next 24 hours. Rainfall amounts over this period could total between 50 to 60 mm.

Given the forecast, we expect a significant rise in rivers and streams throughout the watershed, particularly along the Kaministiquia River. Recent rains have saturated the soils and the threat of flooding exists in low lying areas from heavy downpours due to thunderstorms.

Special caution should be used around rivers and streams. Please alert any children under your care to these dangers and supervise their activities.

Bulletins are issued to advise of Flood Safety or Watershed Conditions. This Safety Bulletin is in effect until 3:00 pm on Friday October 19, 2007, unless conditions change.
