***LAKEHEAD REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY
FLOOD ADVISORY***

The Lakehead Region Conservation Authority advises that area waterways have stabilized and are in the process of receding. The Neebing-McIntyre Floodway has been operation since Thursday evening. The Neebing River is experiencing minor water level rises and expected to crest soon. Some roads in low lying rural areas are experiencing road overtopping, however they are receding.

Although area streams are trending downward flow velocities will remain high. The public are advised to exercise caution in and around area waterways as underlying bank stability may be hazardous.

Authority staff continue to monitor conditions. Updates will be issued as warranted.
