***LAKEHEAD REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY
WATERSHED CONDITIONS BULLETIN***

Small amounts of rain have been recorded at area gauges over the last 24 hours (i.e. approximately 6 mm) much less than originally forecast. Another disturbance is forecasted to bring rain over the next 24 hours. Rainfall amounts over this period could total between 20 to 35 mm.

The threat of flooding still exists in low lying areas from heavy downpours due to thunderstorms.

The public are advised to use extreme caution around area waterways and ditches. Parents are encouraged to discuss the hazards of flooding and fast flowing water with their children.

Authority staff will continue to monitor the situation.

Bulletins are issued to advise of Flood Safety or Watershed Conditions. This Bulletin is in effect until 3:00 pm on Saturday April 26, 2008, unless conditions change.
